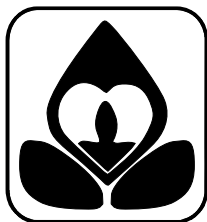

Dear Members,

It is that time of year when we take stock of our efforts and ponder ahead for the future. The age old wisdom goes; time makes obsolete and redundant, that which does not change with it.

At Jivraj, we have not just under taken minor adjustments, but have gone ahead with substantial redirections. The revamping of the entire building and structure at a huge expense is well under-way. The Institute building is more than 32 year old and is being renovated in phase manner to enhance safety, for better compliance with legal and other norms, for controlling and preventing infection and to provide an easy and patient friendly infrastructure. This holistic upgradation is proceeding without disturbing the operations of our hospital.

An institute is not just its edifice. So a defined organizational structure is also now put in place to generate efficiency, fix responsibilities, and prevent waste.

I am glad to report that the entirely new comprehensive Gynecology Department and the new ICU on the third floor with 16 beds including 4 Isolation rooms and with latest high-tech facilities, that I had referred to in my report last, have been completed and would have become operational by the time this report is published. Apart from these, a lot of new equipments and medical infrastructures have been created during the year. Some of these are highlighted in the bullet points referred below.

- Addition of liquid Oxygen tank and upgrade of Central Medical Gas line to ensure purity and availability of Medical gases.
- Addition of 20 Oxygen Concentrator Machines with 10L Capacity.
- Addition of High tech 4 Pediatric Trolley with Thermal Sensors.
- Addition of Chemotherapy Drug preparation Laminar Air flow Chamber.
- Addition of Synthesis Battery operator Drill and ENT high end Microscope in Operation theater.
- Added 12 Latest fully equipped High end ventilator for Critical Care Units.
- Started presence in Social Media network i.e Facebook, Instagram, Youtube, etc. to spread awareness among society.
- Activated presence in various digital media and print media.
- Upgraded Transformer capacity from 500KV to 1000KV to address future expansion in more safer way.
- Addition of new DG set of 250KV capacity (Total 750kv capacity).

These additions and achievements have also not been at the cost of the usual medical camps that have been regularly organized in backward areas by our medical team for the patients suffering from diseases, malnutrition, anemia, etc. Blood donation camps continued to be successfully organized.

It is the faith and confidence generated by the entire Jivraj family that has led to tremendous support by the donors in the last year. In the year 2021-22, our Institute has received the highest ever donation of Rs.11.57 Crore. On my behalf as well as on behalf of the entire Jivraj Family, I convey my heart-felt gratitude to our donors and well-wishers. Independent Auditor's Report

To

Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of **DR JIVRAJ MEHTA SMARAK HEALTH FOUNDATION**, Bakeri Medical Research Centre (**the "Trust"**) which comprise the Balance Sheet at 31st March, 2022 and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year then ended in which are included their Units (**Health Care Unit & Research Unit**) which are separately audited by us, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of Significant Accounting Policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Trust as at 31st March, 2022 and excess of expenditure over income for the year then ended and are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SAs") issued by ICAI. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Trust in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements. An audit is carried out considering the provisions of The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950) and the rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these require-

ments and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Financial Statements

Management of the Trust is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950) that give a true and fair view of the financial position and financial performance in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950) for safeguarding of the assets of the Trust and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management of the Trust is responsible for assessing the Trust's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the entity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Trust's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Trust's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on our audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Trust to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with the relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

Report on Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

As required by The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950) and on the basis of such checks as we considered appropriate and necessary and according to the information and explanations given to us, we report that:

1. The accounts are maintained regularly and in accordance with the provisions of The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950) and the Bombay Public Trusts (Gujarat) Rules, 1961.
2. The Receipts and disbursements are properly and correctly shown in the Accounts.
3. The Cash balances and vouchers are in the custody of the Cashier/Accountant on the date of audit and are in agreement with the Accounts.
4. Books, Deeds, Accounts, vouchers and other documents and records required by us were produced before us.
5. The inventory, certified by the Trustees, of the movable properties of the Trust has been maintained.

6. The Accountant-in-charge appeared before us and furnished the necessary information required by us.
7. The property or Funds of the Trust were not applied for any object or purpose other than the objects or purposes of the Trust.
8. The amounts of Advances outstanding for more than one year are Rs. Nil. and the amounts written off are Rs. 1,64,412/- (P.Y. Rs. 19,246/-)
9. Tenders were not invited but the quotations were obtained in most of the cases for comparative prices in respect of repairs and construction, where the expenditure exceeded Rs. 5,000/- .
10. The Trust has made various investments as shown in Schedule-F to the Financial Statements aggregating to Rs. 22.72 Crore (P.Y. 17.57 Crore) as at 31st March, 2022. Investments to the extent of Rs. 9.50 Crore (P.Y. 5.00 Crore) are contrary to the provisions of Section 35 of The Gujarat Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bom. XXIX of 1950).
11. Separate books of account, records, vouchers and other documents are maintained by Healthcare Unit and Research Unit and are separately audited by us. These Units' separate Financial Statements are also attached along with Trust's Financial Statements.
12. The books of account are maintained on accrual system of accounting.

FOR THE YEAR ENDED ON 31.03.2022**

1. TRUST INFORMATION AND REGISTRATIONS UNDER VARIOUS STATUTES :

(a) Dr. Jivraj Mehta Smarak Health Foundation was registered under the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 on 29.11.1983 having Registration No. F/951/Ahmedabad.

2. As required under the Statute, the Foundation has maintained separate set of books of account for Research and Healthcare units, which are separately audited. Accordingly, along with consolidated financial statements, separate financial statements of Research and Healthcare units are presented herewith.

3. METHOD OF ACCOUNTING :

Method of Accounting is on Accrual Basis.

4. USES OF ESTIMATES :

The Preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting prin-

ciples requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported balances of assets and liabilities and the disclosure relating to contingent liabilities as at the date of financial statements and reported amounts of income and expenses during the reporting period. Although these estimates are based upon management's best knowledge of current events and actions, actual results could differ from those estimates. Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed at each Balance Sheet date. Any revision to accounting estimates is recognized in the period in which the estimate is revised.

5. PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT (PPE) AND DEPRECIATION :

(a) Property, Plant & Equipment :

PPE have been stated at historical cost of acquisition and/or construction. The cost comprises the purchase price, including import duties and non-refundable purchase taxes and such costs directly attributable to bringing the asset to the location and condition necessary for it to be capable of operating in the manner intended by management.

(b) Depreciation / Amortisation:

'Depreciation on PPE has been provided on written down value (WDV) method at the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Rules, 1962.

(c) Lease Hold Land is amortised over the period of lease term i.e. 99 years

(d) Method of Accounting of PPE and depreciation thereon as mentioned in (a) and (b) above are subject to the method of accounting followed in respect of PPE acquired out of CSR funds which is explained in Note No. 6 below.

6. CSR FUNDS, PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT (PPE) AND DEPRECIATION :

(a) The Trust has been registered for undertaking CSR activities as the Implementing Agency for the specified companies which are under CSR obligations as per the provisions of Section 135, Schedule VII and the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014 (as amended), under the Companies Act, 2013. These companies have given CSR donations to the Trust for Ongoing Projects and for Other than Ongoing Projects for creating PPE (medical equipments etc.) and for utilisation on the objects of the Trust.

(b) The accounting policy in regard to measurement, recognition and disclosure of such different CSR funds are as under:

(i) CSR Funds for Ongoing Projects and for Other than Ongoing Projects for creating PPE are shown as Earmarked Funds in the Balance Sheet and funds for utilisation on the objects of the Trust are recognised as Revenue Donations in the Income and Expenditure Account.

(ii) Property, Plant and Equipment created out of CSR Funds where the ownership has been passed on to the Trust have been separately recognised and disclosed in the Schedule of Property, Plant and Equipment. (Schedule-B).

(iii) PPE created out of CSR Funds for the Hospital has been measured and recognised in the Financial Statements of Healthcare Unit.

(iv) No Depreciation has been provided in the books of account in respect of such PPE created out of CSR Funds (either shown in the Financial Statements of Research Unit or Healthcare Unit).

7. ASSETS IN KIND :

Any PPE received by the Trust in kind where the ownership has been passed on to the Trust has been valued at Fair Value. No depreciation has been provided in the books of account on such PPE received in kind.

8. REVENUE RECOGNITION :

(a) Revenue is recognised when consideration can be measured reliably and there exists reasonable certainty of its recovery.

(b) Healthcare Income is recognised as and when services are rendered which normally coincides when invoices are raised.

(c) Pharmacy Income is recognised as and when the medicines are sold to the patients.

(d) Interest Income is recognised on time proportion basis.

9. INVESTMENTS :

Investments are stated at the cost price.

10. INVENTORIES :

Inventory of Drugs, Medicines and other consumables are valued at cost, as taken, valued and certified by the management.

11. Common expenses including depreciation/ amortisation (other than directly attributable to any specific unit) are allocated/ apportioned between Healthcare Unit and Research Unit in the ratio of 70:30 respectively.

12. In the opinion of the management, the current assets and loans and advances are approximately of the value stated, if realized in the ordinary course of the Trust's activities and all known liabilities have been fully provided for in the books of account unless otherwise stated.

13. Outstanding balances as on 31st March, 2022 in respect of Sundry Credit balances, Other Liabilities, Receivables, Advances and Deposits given are subject to confirmation, reconciliation and adjustments, if any.

14. Previous year's figures have been regrouped, re-arranged or re-classified wherever necessary to make them comparable with the current year's figures.
